Notice inviting Application for the scheme "Integrated Farming (IF)" Laying Out of Demonstration Plot (LoDP) in farmers field – Direct Implementation (DI) – Karnataka – 2024-25

Coconut Board invites Applications / proposals in the prescribed format, from the interested Farmers' Collectives of the districts, where coconut is cultivated as a predominant crop, for the direct implementation of Board's programme "IF" LoDP in farmers field on cluster basis, for the improvement of the Production & productivity of the existing gardens, through the farmer participatory approach, during 2024-25, abiding with the Rules & Regulations of the Board.

The objective of the programme is to improve production and productivity of the coconut holdings through an integrated approach.

Financial assistance is limited to Rs.35,000/- per ha (100% central assistance) in two equal annual installments depending on the activities undertaken in the coconut gardens with a view to demonstrate the technologies for improving the productivity and income through Integrated Farming, with all possible convergence with other suitable schemes.

The financial assistance is limited to the cost of critical inputs, planting materials of intercrops, green manure seeds, plant protection chemicals etc. Expenses on labour component, other rental services, development of infrastructure, etc. are not considered under the scheme.

Being the demonstration of the productivity improvement through application of critical inputs is the primary activity under the scheme, the funds for the same shall not be diverted for other inputs/ components.

Terms & Conditions.


- The application /proposal should be submitted in the prescribed format only.
- Active Coconut Farmer Clusters and other FPOs can apply for the programme.
- The application from the Coconut Farmer Cluster will not be considered if the farmers have already availed benefits under the LoDP or R & R schemes of the Board, either directly implemented by the CDB or through the State Horticulture Department, during the past 5 years.
- Coconut should be a predominant crop in the proposed cluster & which has to cover an area of minimum 80 % of the total cultivated area of that cluster.
- The proposed cluster area should be contiguous in nature with clear natural boundaries on all four sides. The cluster area should be within a range of **25 ha to 200 ha**.
- All the coconut Farmers who have a minimum of 10 yielding palms within the cluster should be enrolled as beneficiaries of the scheme, irrespective of their member ship in CPS/CPF/CPC or any other FPOs.
- All the eligible coconut holdings in the area shall be covered so as to enable the cluster level approach of implementation.
- All the farmers in the proposed cluster should be ready to adopt scientific cultivation practices (INM, IPM, IDM & IWM), which include application of the chemical fertilizers / PPC etc.

- All farmers in the proposed cluster should be ready to adopt Basin opening, shade regulation and application of green leaves, organic manure/FYM etc at the onset of the monsoon, at their own cost.
- The applications from the CFCs, with inappropriate areas for coconut cultivation within the cluster such as, water logged / converted paddy field / low lying area, thickly populated with wild trees etc., will not considered for the programme.
- Assistance under the scheme will be limited to a maximum area of 1 ha per beneficiary.
 The funds required over & above the CDB allocation, if any, have to be borne by the farmer
 to provide the same scientific management practices to the coconut palms not covered
 under the scheme.
- If selected, the CFC will have to authorize CDB to adjust the eligible subsidy amount under the scheme with the inputs supplied on credit basis and to effect the payment directly to a/c of the Input suppliers.
- Priority will be given to the Coconut Farmer Clusters where similar schemes of CDB were not implemented earlier.
- CDB will identify the suitable area / CFC for implementation of the scheme during 2024-25, based on the merit & scope of the valid proposals received and in accordance with the budgetary allocation with special focus to identified thrust areas.
- The authority for the selection of Coconut Farmers Cluster for the implementation of the scheme is vested with CDB and the decision of the CEO will be final in this regard.
- Incomplete application & applications without requisite documents will be summarily rejected.
- If preliminarily selected, the cluster area to be surveyed by the CFC and all the basic data of the garden/ farmers shall be recorded in the prescribed format through a base line survey. The data collected from the base line survey is required to be compiled and entered in the prescribed Excel format within the specified time frame, at their own risk and cost.
- An abstract project should be prepared by the CFC and submitted to Board within the stipulated time.
- The applications / Proposals should reach the CDB Regional Office, Bangalore on or before 5 pm of 12-07-2024. The application may be addressed to the Director, Coconut Development Board, Regional Office, Kerabhavan, Hulimavu, Bannerghatta Road, Bangalore- 560 076. The applications / Proposals received after the stipulated time will not be considered.
